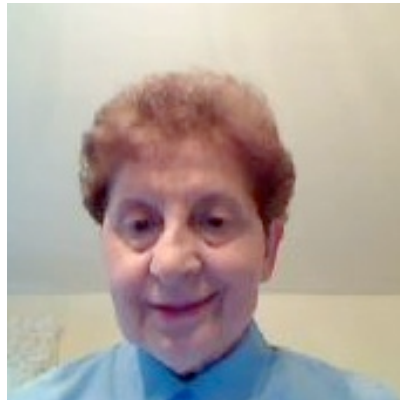

Gen Battisto is retired from the Pocono Mountain School District, where she served for 35 years as a mathematics teacher, department chair, and mathematics supervisor. Since her retirement, she has taught mathematics education courses as an adjunct instructor at Marywood University and the University of Scranton. Also, as a consultant, she has facilitated professional development in elementary and secondary mathematics at numerous districts and IUs in eastern and central Pennsylvania. She is currently a mentor for instructional coaches in the Pennsylvania High School Coaching Initiative.

Gen has been a part of many Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) projects, including Diagnostic-Prescriptive Mathematics, Mathematics for the 21st Century Task Force, and the writing teams for the PA Mathematics Outcomes and Mathematics Standards. She has been active in professional organizations, including PCTM, where she has served on the Executive Board for at least 20 years, co-chaired annual meetings, and co-chaired the membership growth committee. Gen is a charter member of PCSM and has served as its vice-president, president, chair of the awards committee, and where she has been a recipient of the PCSM Supervisor Hall of Fame Award. She has also spoken at many state and national mathematics meetings.
